

BAROQUE DESK/VANITY



Description: This was a private project of Jürgen Eberl. The table is similar in shape and measurements to a table found in the Louvre, a picture of which can be seen in Pierre Ramond's book, Marquetry. The details of the marquetry—the inlaid wood designs, the accent lines, etc.—He did himself.



Base wood: Walnut

Veneer: Rosewood, Kingwood, Mahogany, Snake-wood, Purpleheart

Marquetry: Maple, Boxwood, Red Satin, Apple, Ironwood, Plum, Ebony, Maple Burr, Perlmutter, Rio Palisander, Olivewood

I used only saw-cut veneer with a thickness of 1-1.5 mm.

Fittings and Mechanism: Most of the metal parts were hand-made, built mostly by myself or with help from friends.

Glue: Bone and fish glue
